Complimentary hors d' oeuvres and beverages are generally available while you browse or shop. Be sure to allow time for a leisurely dinner at one of our many restaurants.

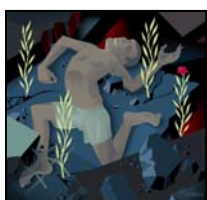

The BobLo Steamers: Matriarchs of the Detroit River March 10



Remember packing up the kids and a picnic lunch and heading to the Boblo boat dock in Detroit to spend the day on Boblo Island? Boblo Island Amusement Park was a getaway from the hustle and bustle of city life. Half the fun was getting there.

Dancing in the moonlight on the Boblo boat moonlight cruises was more popular with an older crowd than those who traveled on the boat just to get to the rides. The cruises were all about dancing and socializing on the Detroit River.



Two steamers made especially for the BobLo run were the Columbia in 1902 and the Ste. Claire in 1910, both designed by Frank E. Kirby. They are the last two steamers of their type with integrity left in the United States. The pair shared their original run from Detroit to Bob-Lo Island for 81 years, a record of service on a single run equaled in U. S. maritime history.

Learn about the history and future of these historic steamers. Lori Feret has been working on a restoration project for the Columbia. Her presentation will include video footage and slides. Please call to reserve your seat.

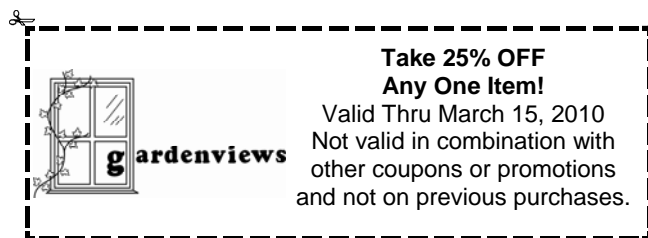

Business Assistance Program

The Northville DDA created the Business Assistance Program in December 2007 to assist Downtown Northville property owners and their tenants who are interested in making physical improvements to their commercial building and/or for technical assistance.

The goal of the program is to encourage economic investment within Downtown Northville. The Northville DDA believes that by providing incentives to spur revitalization and reinvestment in structures within the DDA district, a more attractive downtown will be created.

Since the program's inception more than \$121,000 has been approved for Commercial Improvement Grants and \$5,000 for Technical Assistance Grants. More information including a summary of awards approved during our first three cycles is available on the DDA website.

Additional improvements to downtown building facades will be evident this summer due to the success of the Business Assistance Program.
